The Board of Supervisors of Clinton County, Iowa, met. Present were Supervisors Irwin and Srp. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

9:00 A.M. Review Correspondence and Claims Call to Order – Pledge of Allegiance

Claims were approved unanimously

Coronavirus/COVID-19 update: County Community Health Manager Michelle Cullen reported there were 12 new cases in the County in the last three days and 62 in the last week. She said the concerning matter is the hospitalizations that, in the region, have gone from 48 to 57. Genesis and Mercy hospitalizations have stayed stable at 16 and 4 respectively. There are currently seven Clinton County residents hospitalized at various facilities. She said there were two more deaths recorded this week and the positivity rate has increased from 8% to 9.1%. She said the good news is almost 17% of County population completed the immunization series and 11% have started the series. Cullen said those numbers continue to increase as the vaccinations are now open for anyone to sign up. She said a good portion of the manufacturers in Clinton County have been vaccinated. She said they will start working on the other prioritized groups this week.

DEPARTMENT HEADS, ELECTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES

County Facilities Director Corey Johnson reported the parking lot and roofing contractors will be meeting tomorrow to discuss plans for them to work together. He said easements are ready for the neighbors to the Administration Building to consider. He said OSHA training is being done for his staff on Wednesday.

Supervisor Srp said he attended the Goose Lake RAGBRAI meeting and will meet again on April 13. He said the City of Goose Lake was happy to see County representatives were there to offer assistance.

Supervisor Irwin said last week he attended a meeting in Wheatland in regards to the Wapsi River bridges. He said it was well attended. He said the Board meeting on April 14 may be moved to the Calamus-Wheatland High School Activity Center due to the amount of people who attended last week's meeting. Irwin said that will be decided after County IT reviews the center for WebEx options.

County Treasurer Dustin Johnson said the second-half property tax collection due date passed last week. He said there is currently \$2.4 million delinquent from expected second-half payments. He said that is higher than normal, but taxpayers usually respond after delinquencies are sent out.

DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION

American Queen County Courthouse Tours: County Auditor Eric Van Lancker said he was asked by the Clinton Convention and Visitors Bureau about the tours starting again after a two-year hiatus. He said he spoke about that with the facilities director. Van Lancker said there doesn't appear to be an issue with the tours starting again. He did inform the CVB that it was not County officials who gave the tours and that there could still be mask mandates in the building at the time. CVB officials said the river tours have already implemented mask mandates and will look into hosts for the tours. Van Lancker said the dates for the three tours are in July, August and October. He said no action is required by the Board, but wanted the Board to know that was in the works.

9:45 A.M. Public Hearing

Vice-Chairman Irwin called a public hearing to order to solicit comments on the proposed Secondary Roads Five-Year Plan.

Present were Supervisor Srp, County Auditor Van Lancker, County Engineer Kinney, public and media. Proof of publication was presented, accepted and returned for filing.

Kinney reviewed the plan. He said adding a bridge near Wheatland and Calamus may be included in the plan even though it's possible nothing will be done with it.

No comments were received.
