DEPARTMENT HEADS, ELECTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES

County Auditor Eric Van Lancker reminded the Board it has a scheduled meeting for tomorrow for budget work sessions and ARP funding discussion. He said the Special Low Moor Election is next week.

Supervisor Srp thanked Lt. Tom Paarmann of the Sheriff's Office for his 33 years of service.

Supervisor Irwin said the Iowa State Extension is running a program about farming and mental health and he has passed that information to the Mental Health region. He said the Mississippi Valley Workforce Development area has gone out to bid for a fiscal agent. He said there was some discussion about a bid being required, but he believes the Board can go out for a bid at any time.

Chairman Determann said he met with the Clinton County Farm Bureau with Todd Kinney on Tuesday night. He said roads and solar farms were major topics.

County Treasurer Dustin Johnson reported contiguous county titling testing has been completed and will start this week. He said he knows of six dealerships interested in using Clinton County for titles. Johnson said his DeWitt office could also assist the County Sheriff's Office with gun permit applications.

Sheriff Greenwalt thanked the County Auditor's Office for providing prompt payroll training. Van Lancker said his Office Administrator Kehly Kennedy-Ivory was instrumental in that training.

County Conservation Director Phillip Visser provided an update on events happening in Conservation. He said campsite reservations for the summer are starting to fill up.

County Engineer Todd Kinney will be working with the City of Clinton to select a RAISE grant engineer. He said work on the bridge south of Grand Mound started last week.

DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION

Mental Health Region Update: Supervisor Irwin said each County in the region will need to approve a conflict of interest waiver due to funding for Life Connections in DeWitt. The organization asked for \$300,000 grant from the region. He said county attorneys from around the region gave conflicting opinions on how to deal with the grant. He said it was suggested the region ask Ahlers & Cooney to represent the region in the grant issue. Lori Elam said Ahlers & Cooney was worried about working with the region since several counties in the region are their clients. But they did provide some suggestions about how to write the grant to avoid the funds being used to purchase a new home for the organization. Elam said they spoke with Robert Young Center about tying the contract with the

services they offer. Elam said they have not been able to get guidance from the Iowa Auditor's Offices as how to handle the assistance with Life Connections.

County Historic Preservation Update: Supervisor Srp reported the commission needs the Board to approve its annual report.
