

**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**NOTICE OF SPECIAL ELECTION**

Notice is hereby given that an election, being a Special Election of the Central Clinton Community School District, County of Clinton, State of Iowa, has been called and ordered to be held Tuesday, April 2, 2013. Proposition A: Shall the Board of Directors of the Central Clinton Community School District be authorized for a period of ten (10) years, to levy annually, as determined by the Board, a voter-approved physical plant and equipment property tax not to exceed sixty-seven cents (67¢) per one thousand dollars (\$1,0000.00) of the assessed valuation of the taxable property within the school district commencing with the levy for collection in the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2014, to be used for the purposes permitted by Iowa law?

Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. in the evening of the same day.

Voters are reminded of the requirements of voter registration. A Clinton County registered voter may change his/her address on election day, and a person may change their name on election day. Voters are reminded if they have moved, they must vote in their new precinct. It will be necessary for a voter to produce color photo identification at the new precinct to change their address.

As per 48A.7A – a person who is eligible to register to vote may register on election day by appearing in person at the polling place for the precinct in which the individual resides and completing a voter registration application, making written oath, and providing proof of identity and residence.

There will be only one polling place, a vote center, for the Central Clinton Community School District at:

First Congregational UCC  
520 E 11<sup>th</sup> St, DeWitt

Absentee and special voter ballots will be counted at the Charles A Sheridan Building, 405 20<sup>th</sup> Ave N, Clinton. Voting equipment will be used at the election and the ballot is substantially as printed.

At the election all of the qualified voters of the Central Clinton Community School District are hereby notified to appear at the time and place. All voters are also advised as to the requirements of voter registration in order to be eligible to vote at the election.
