NOTICE OF REGULAR CITY ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that an election, being the Regular City Election of the City of Clinton, County of Clinton, State of Iowa, has been called and ordered to be held Tuesday, November 5, 2013. At said election two (2) council-at-large members will be elected for a term of four (4) years, the voters of the first ward will elect a ward council person for a term of four (4) years, the voters of the second ward will elect a ward council person to fill a vacancy term for two (2) years, and the voters of the third ward will elect a ward council person for a term of four (4) years. Further, there will be two propositions to be voted on, Proposition E to authorize a change in the use of the one percent (1%) local sales and services tax in the City of Clinton and Proposition F to authorize the City of Clinton to levy a tax for the purpose of funding a capital improvement program to support capital projects associated with sewer and storm sewer systems effective July 1, 2014.

Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. in the evening of the same day.

Voters are reminded of the requirements of voter registration. A Clinton County registered voter may change his/her address on election day, and a person may change their name on election day. Voters are reminded if they have moved, they must vote in their new precinct. It will be necessary for a voter to produce color photo identification at the new precinct to change their address.

As per 48A.7A – a person who is eligible to register to vote may register on election day by appearing in person at the polling place for the precinct in which the individual resides and completing a voter registration application, making written oath, and providing proof of identity and residence.

Absentee and special voter ballots will be counted at the Charles A. Sheridan Building, 405 20th Ave. N., Clinton. Optical scan machines will be used at the election and the ballot is substantially as printed.

At the election all of the qualified voters of the City of Clinton are hereby notified to appear at the time and place. All voters are also advised as to the requirements of voter registration in order to be eligible to vote at the election.
