**Absentee Voting Begins  
at Clinton County Auditor's Office**

CLINTON – Clinton County Auditor Eric Van Lancker has announced that absentee ballots for the November 8, 2016, General Election are available to be voted in the Clinton County Auditor's Office on Thursday, September 29, 2016.

Absentee ballots may be cast in the Clinton County Auditor's Office at the Clinton County Administration Building, 1900 N. 3<sup>rd</sup> St., Clinton, IA, during regular office hours from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, through November 7. The Clinton County Auditor's Office will also be open Saturday, October 29, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m. and Saturday, November 5, from 8 a.m. to 5 p.m.

Absentee ballots must be requested in writing. Forms are available at the Auditor's Office, on the Clinton County Web site at [www.clintoncounty-ia.gov](http://www.clintoncounty-ia.gov) and at the Iowa Secretary of State's Web site at [www.sos.state.ia.us](http://www.sos.state.ia.us).

All requests for ballots to be mailed must be received by the Auditor's Office by 5 p.m., November 4. Ballots returned to the Auditor's Office through the mail must be returned and postmarked by midnight, November 7.
