WHEREAS, the epidemic places undue burden on Iowa's Public Safety, Public Health, Human Services, Health Care, Education, Employment and Treatment systems; and

WHEREAS, methamphetamine treatment is effective in interrupting the cycle of addiction and abuse; and

WHEREAS, the support and commitment and involvement of the entire community is needed in order to solve this problem; and

NOW, THEREFORE WE, THE MEMBERS OF THE CLINTON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS, HEREBY PROCLAIM MAY 2015 TO BE

APPROVAL OF WAIVER OF CLINTON COUNTY'S RIGHT TO APPEAL ISSUANCE  
OF FINAL CONSTRUCTION PERMIT FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A CONFINED ANIMAL  
FEEDING OPERATION BY THE IOWA DEPARTMENT OF NATURAL RESOURCES

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE CLINTON COUNTY BOARD OF SUPERVISORS AS FOLLOWS:

- Section 1 The Clinton County Board of Supervisors has received notice from the Iowa Department of Natural Resources (DNR) that Nate Denger has been issued a draft permit for the construction of a confined animal feeding operation building(s) at 1426 235th Avenue in unincorporated Clinton County.
- Section 2 The Clinton County Board of Supervisors reviewed the construction permit application and the manure management plan and determined that both appeared to be in compliance with the requirements of the Master Matrix, Iowa Code Section 459, and Iowa DNR rules and recommended approval of said application on April 14, 2015.
- Section 3 The Clinton County Board of Supervisors hereby waives its right to appeal the issuance of the final permit within the fourteen (14) day limit from the time of receipt of notice of the issuance of the draft permit.
- Section 4 The Clinton County Board of Supervisors encourages the Iowa DNR to issue the Final Permit immediately upon notification of this waiver.
- Section 5 The Clinton County Board of Supervisors authorizes the Board Chairman to notify the Iowa DNR of this waiver.
- Section 6 This resolution shall take effect immediately.

GENERAL PUBLIC

DEPARTMENT HEADS, ELECTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES

County Building Maintenance Manager Corey Johnson updated the Board of Supervisors on the courthouse clock repair project and asked the Board for recommendations as to when they would like the bell to ring. Suggested times were daily at 12:00 noon and various holidays. Johnson said he would like to submit those times to the contractor so that the bell can be programmed now and then tested after the clock is re-installed. Supervisor Srp suggested an email be sent to the County Attorney and District Court Judges to ensure the ringing of the bell would not interfere with the courts. Srp said that he has concerns for the surrounding residents that they don't want the ringing it to be excessive. Supervisor Hamerlinck stated that based on the historical background of the clock and bell, he would like the clock re-installed as soon as possible. Johnson said the bell can be programmed now and changed later as he will be trained to program it. He also added that he had Jansen Construction & Restoration out of Vinton, Iowa, here this week to look at the roof on the courthouse. There are bids submitted for the repair project and this will be the last bid that should be coming in. Johnson would like to schedule a work session to discuss the bids received to review the bids and warranties. Hamerlinck added the he would like to look at where the money will be coming from, capital account or general fund or decrease other expenditures for the next fiscal year.

County Planning & Zoning Director Nate Mueller informed the Board of Supervisors that he would be out of the office from Wednesday to Friday next week to attend the annual COZO conference.

Hamerlinck thanked the Board for being flexible and adjusting the meeting dates to Tuesday. As of June 1<sup>st</sup>, the meetings will be back on the Monday schedule and asked that the Auditor notify the media. He also stated that he would not be able to attend the Mental Health Board meeting on Friday at 3:00 p.m., and asked if either of the other Board members were able to attend in his absence.
