**Camanche School Special Election Absentee  
Voting Begins March 23**

CLINTON – Clinton County Auditor Eric Van Lancker has announced that absentee ballots for the April 7, 2015, Camanche Community School District Special Election are available in the Clinton County Auditor’s Office starting Monday, March 23, 2015.

Absentee ballots may be cast in the Clinton County Auditor’s Office at the Clinton County Administration Building, 1900 N. 3<sup>rd</sup> St., Clinton, IA, during regular office hours from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, through April 6, 2015.

The ballot for the Special Elections includes selecting a candidate to fill a vacancy on the school board and a public measure asking for approval of a physical plant and equipment property tax for the Camanche School District.

Only voters who reside in the Camanche Community School District are allowed to vote in the Special Election.

Absentee ballots must be requested in writing. Request forms are available at the Auditor’s Office, on the Clinton County Web site at [www.clintoncounty-ia.gov](http://www.clintoncounty-ia.gov) and at the Iowa Secretary of State’s Web site at [www.sos.state.ia.us](http://www.sos.state.ia.us). Ballots requested through the mail must be returned and postmarked by midnight, April 6, 2015. Ballots may also be hand-delivered to the Auditor’s Office before 8 p.m. on April 7, 2015.

All requests for ballots to be mailed must be received by the Auditor’s Office by 5 p.m., April 2 as the office is closed for the holiday April 3.
