Clinton County, IA: Preparation for construction of new Law Center

Clinton County, IA: Clinton County Justice Coordinating Commission (CCJCC) and Clinton County Building Maintenance Office announce preparations and developments for the new Law Center, which will house the Clinton County Jail/Sheriff's Office/911 Emergency Communications Center & Emergency Management Agency and Emergency Operations Center. Site work is starting today.

A new building on the southwest side of the Courthouse will house temporary heating and cooling of the Courthouse, as preparations are underway for the new Law Center. Clinton County Maintenance Director Corey Johnson stated, "This building will provide heating and cooling to the Courthouse during construction time. After construction is completed, this structure will become the Maintenance workshop/garage area, which is replacing the boiler house."

Johnson also said, "You will see this building take shape over the next few weeks. We are anticipating boiler house demolition in October or early November when ground work starts."

Tree removal will be on the southwest corner of the Courthouse and three trees will be removed in front of the current Law Center. One conifer (which is dead) in front of the Courthouse will be removed and replaced immediately.

There will be future landscape plans as the new facility is complete. Tree removal will be complete today and no additional trees will be removed.

The referendum was approved by 73.9% on May 3, 2016. ShiveHattery is providing the Architectural services for the project and the Samuels Group is the Construction Manager.
