NOTICE OF REGULAR CITY ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that an election, being the Regular City Election of the City of Delmar, County of Clinton, State of Iowa, has been called and ordered to be held Tuesday, November 3, 2009. At said election a mayor will be elected for a term of two (2) years, two (2) council members will be elected for a term of four (4) years, and one (1) council member will be elected for a term of two (2) years (to fill a vacancy).

Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. in the evening of the same day.

Voters are reminded of the requirements of voter registration. A Clinton County registered voter may change his/her address on election day, and a woman may change her name on election day. Voters are reminded if they have moved, they must vote in their new precinct. It will be necessary for a voter to produce color photo identification at the new precinct to change their address.

As per 48A.7A – a person who is eligible to register to vote may register on election day by appearing in person at the polling place for the precinct in which the individual resides and completing a voter registration application, making written oath, and providing proof of identity and residence.

Absentee and special voter ballots will be counted at the Charles A. Sheridan Building, 405 20th Ave. N., Clinton. Optical scan machines will be used at the election and the ballot is substantially as follows:
