Primary Election Absentee Ballots Available

CLINTON – Clinton County Auditor Eric Van Lancker has announced that absentee ballots will be available beginning April 29, 2010, in the Clinton County Auditor's Office for the June 8, 2010, Primary Election.

Registered voters who will not be able to vote at their precinct on June 8 may request and vote an absentee ballot in person at the Auditor's office in the Clinton County Administration Building, 1900 N. Third St., Clinton.

A registered voter may also make a written request for an absentee ballot by mail by filling out an absentee ballot request form. That request must include the voter's name, address, date of birth, name of the election and either the voter's Iowa driver's license number or the last four digits of their social security number. The request must be signed by the person requesting the ballot and the request should be mailed to the Clinton County Auditor; P.O. Box 2957; Clinton, IA; 52733-2957. The deadline for requesting an absentee ballot by mail is 5 p.m. Friday, June 4.

An absentee ballot request form can be found on the Clinton County Web site at www.clintoncounty-ia.gov or at Secretary of State Michael Mauro's Web site at <http://www.sos.state.ia.us>.

The ballots will be mailed out within 24 hours of receipt of the request. Voters are responsible for returning ballots to the Auditor's office before the polls close on June 8 at 9 p.m.

Those wishing to vote absentee at the Clinton County Auditor's office may do so between the hours of 8 a.m. and 4:30 p.m., Monday through Friday, until June 7, and between 8 a.m. and 5 p.m. on two Saturdays, May 29 and June 5. A voter may not pick up a ballot at the office and take it with them. Ballots must be mailed to voters or voted in the office.

Van Lancker recommends those who are not yet registered to vote in the Primary Election to register with the Auditor's office before 5 p.m. on May 29. While election day registration will be available for the Primary Election, Van Lancker encourages all citizens to register to vote in advance of any election.
