NOTICE OF REGULAR SCHOOL ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that an election, being the Regular School Election of the Delwood Community School District, in the Counties of Clinton and Jackson, State of Iowa, has been called and ordered to be held Tuesday, September 13, 2011, to elect one (1) Director-At-Large for a term of four (4) years, one (1) Director for Director District 1 for a term of four (4) years, and one (1) Director for Director District 2 for a term of four (4) years.

Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. in the evening of the same day.

Voters are reminded of the requirements of voter registration. A Clinton and Jackson County registered voter may change his/her address on election day, and a woman may change her name on election day. Voters are reminded if they have moved, they must vote in their new precinct. It will be necessary for a voter to produce color photo identification at the new precinct to change their address.

As per 48A.7A – a person who is eligible to register to vote may register on election day by appearing in person at the polling place for the precinct in which the individual resides and completing a voter registration application, making written oath, and providing proof of identity and residence.

Absentee and special voter ballots will be counted at the Clinton County Administration Building, 1900 N 3rd Street, Clinton. Voting equipment will be used at the election and the ballot is substantially as follows:
