**School Election Absentee Voting  
Begins at Clinton County Auditor's Office**

CLINTON – Clinton County Auditor Eric Van Lancker has announced that absentee ballots for the September 13, 2011, School Elections are available in the Clinton County Auditor's Office on Thursday, August 25, 2011.

Absentee ballots may be cast in the Clinton County Auditor's Office at the Clinton County Administration Building, 1900 N. 3<sup>rd</sup> St., Clinton, IA, during regular office hours from 8 a.m. to 4:30 p.m. Monday through Friday, through September 12. Absentee ballots are available for the following school district elections: Calamus-Wheatland, Camanche, Central, Clinton, Delwood and Northeast.

Absentee ballots must be requested in writing. Request forms are available at the Auditor's Office, on the Clinton County Web site at [www.clintoncounty-ia.gov](http://www.clintoncounty-ia.gov) and at the Iowa Secretary of State's Web site at [www.sos.state.ia.us](http://www.sos.state.ia.us). Ballots requested through the mail must be returned and postmarked by midnight, September 12. Ballots may also be hand-delivered to the Auditor's Office on September 13.

All requests for ballots to be mailed must be received by the Auditor's Office by 5 p.m., September 9.
