The Board of Supervisors of Clinton County, Iowa, met. Present were Supervisors Staszewski, Davisson and Schmidt. The minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

8:30 A.M. Dual Elvira Wastewater System Discussion – Board of Health & Board of Supervisors

Larry Nagle, ECIA representative, and Bob Summers, Clinton County Sanitarian, presented the background of the Elvira wastewater system issue. Nagle said the main issue is being able to install a system at an affordable rate for the residents of Elvira.

Supervisor Jill Davisson said the Iowa DNR has cited the County to address this issue. Davisson serves on the EIRUSS board through ECIA to assist small communities to install wastewater/water systems. Davisson said the Board of Supervisors needs direction from the Board of Health on how it wants the issue addressed. She said EIRRUS also needs to be informed by the Board of Health what role it is expected to play.

The Board of Health was in agreement it would like to research a cluster-system using a sub-surface discharge plan with the assistance of EIRRUS.

Motion was made by Supervisor Davisson to authorize the Board of Supervisors to engage EIRRUS in engineering services for a wastewater system in Elvira.
