NOTICE OF REGULAR CITY ELECTION

Notice is hereby given that an election, being the Regular City Election of the City of Andover, County of Clinton, State of Iowa, has been called and ordered to be held Tuesday, November 5, 2013. At said election a mayor and five (5) council members will be elected, all for a term of two (2) years. Further, a proposition is to be voted on to authorize a change in the use of the one percent (1%) local sales and services tax in the City of Andover.

Polls will be open from 12:00 p.m. until 8:00 p.m. in the evening of the same day.

Voters are reminded of the requirements of voter registration. A Clinton County registered voter may change his/her address on election day, and a person may change their name on election day. Voters are reminded if they have moved, they must vote in their new precinct. It will be necessary for a voter to produce color photo identification at the new precinct to change their address.

As per 48A.7A – a person who is eligible to register to vote may register on election day by appearing in person at the polling place for the precinct in which the individual resides and completing a voter registration application, making written oath, and providing proof of identity and residence.

The polling place for the City of Andover is as follows:

Absentee and special voter ballots will be counted at the Charles A. Sheridan Building, 405 20th Ave. N., Clinton. Paper ballots will be used at the election and the ballot is substantially as printed.

At the election all of the qualified voters of the City of Andover are hereby notified to appear at the time and place. All voters are also advised as to the requirements of voter registration in order to be eligible to vote at the election.

The above Notice of Election for the City of Andover is given by order of the council of the City of Andover in the County of Clinton, State of Iowa, and the county commissioner of elections.
