Clinton County Voters to Receive New Voter Registration Cards

CLINTON – Clinton County Auditor and Commissioner of Elections Eric Van Lancker said voters do not need to return new voter cards unless the information on the card is incorrect.

The new voter cards have recently been mailed to registered voters in the County.

Van Lancker said the county-wide mailing is a result of the recent re-districting to voting precincts in Clinton County.

“We thought that following the re-districting, it was a good time to send new voter cards to registered voters in the County because that card will inform the voter of their polling locations for all elections conducted in Clinton County,” Van Lancker said.

The card contains language as prescribed by the Code of Iowa that instructs the voter to return the card. Van Lancker said the voter only needs to return the card if the voter’s information is incorrect.

Re-districting takes place every 10 years following a census count. As a result of the census, Clinton County reduced its number of voting precincts from 30 to 26. The voting precinct lines in the cities of Camanche, Clinton and DeWitt were also changed.
