### **Precinct Election Officials Needed for Primary Election**

CLINTON – Clinton County Auditor and Commissioner of Elections Eric Van Lancker is seeking Clinton County residents who would like to work at the election polls for the June 3, 2014, Primary Election.

Precinct Election Officials are paid minimum wage for working at the polls. The hours are from 6 a.m. to 10 p.m. on Election Day. A training lasting approximately two hours the week before the election is also required.

“It is a long day, but it is a rewarding day,” Van Lancker said. “Our precinct election officials mostly enjoy the feeling of fulfilling their civic duty by participating in their election process and we appreciate their time.”

To work at the polls, a person must be a Clinton County resident and be registered to vote in Clinton County. Citizens are needed to work the polls in all precincts of Clinton County.
