

Get Ready !

To Apply for or Renew your Health Insurance Marketplace Coverage, gather the following information:

- ✓ Information about your household size and about everyone applying for coverage.
- ✓ Federal income Taxes.
- ✓ Social Security Number (SSN)
- ✓ Birth Dates/Certificate
- ✓ Pay Stub, W2 Form
- ✓ Current health Insurance Policy Numbers.
- ✓ Information about any health insurance your or your family could get from your employer.
- ✓ Email address. If you don't have one a temporary can be created.
- ✓ Your best estimate of your household income for 2015.
- ✓ Home & and/or mailing addresses for everyone applying for coverage.

Special Enrollment Period:

Still needing Coverage for 2015?

You may qualify for a "Special Enrollment Period" due to a Qualifying Life Event.

The most common Qualifying Life Events are listed below.

You are very likely eligible if you:

- Lost health coverage in the last 60 days or expect to lose it within the next 60 days
- Got a divorce and lost health insurance.
- Got married.
- Gave birth.
- Adopted a child or had a foster child placed in your home.
- Had a death in your household.
- No longer live in your current health plan's coverage area (e.g. moved to a new state).
- Had a change in household income.
- Became a U.S. citizen.

Other Qualifying Life Events include:

- A prolonged illness that required hospitalization.
- A temporary cognitive disability.
- An enrollment error made by an insurer, government entity, or insurance agent..
- Being released from prison or detention.

Web Sites:

IOWA MEDICAID is now called The Iowa Health & Wellness Plan . The plan has two options for adults ages 19 to 64.

Dhs.iowa.gov

- Iowa Wellness Plan is an Iowa Medicaid program.
 - Eligible member's income is at or below 100% of the FPL. Members can choose a provider from the statewide Medicaid provider network & are able to get care from local providers.
- Iowa Marketplace Choice Plan covers member with an income from 101% through 133% of the FPL. This plan allows members to get health care coverage through select insurers with plans on the Health Insurance Marketplace.
 - Medicaid pays the premiums of the plan for the members.
 - Members get care from providers approved by the health plan.

Applying for Benefits:

- Check eligibility. Welcomes you to a Self Assessment to tell you what benefits your household may qualify for and is it worth your time to apply.
- Apply for Assistance. Create an account and log in. A user Name and Password will be required.
