

PREPARE TO APPLY

The Marketplace offers different types of health plans to meet a variety of need and budgets. You'll need to figure out how much you want to spend on health coverage each month.

Most people using the Marketplace will qualify to save money. To find out how much you're eligible for when you apply, it will help to have these things close by:

- Social security numbers (or document numbers for legal immigrants)
- Birth dates
- Pay stubs, W-2 forms or "Wage and Tax statement"
- Policy numbers for any current health insurance information about any health insurance you or your family could get from your employer.

All health plans offered on the Marketplace must cover a comprehensive set of benefits:

- Prescriptions

Plans must also treat everyone fairly. Discrimination against pre-existing conditions will be banned.
