

AUGUST 10, 2020

The Board of Supervisors of Clinton County, Iowa, met. Present were Supervisors Srp, Determann and Irwin. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

REPORTS

The 4th Quarter FY20 report of the Sheriff's Fees and Expenses was presented, approved and filed.

Coronavirus/COVID-19 update: County Community Health Manager Michelle Cullen reported there are currently 250 active cases in the County and six of those are hospitalized. She said on Thursday there were 36 hospitalized in the region. Cullen said the County continues to see a rise. She said 19 new cases were identified during the weekend. and the positivity rate in Clinton County is currently 13%. She said that number should be less than 10%. Cullen said people don't seem to want to distance from large groups. She said more of the public needs to wear a mask in public. Clinton County EMA Director Chance Kness said the Governor released additional funding for local governments. He said he is currently working on PPE shipments to various school districts in the County. Kness said the PPE supply is good for now and is monitoring the supply of some things that are becoming hard to find. Srp said he asked Kness about status for County buildings considering the increasing numbers. He said there is no current recommendation to close the County buildings to the public. Cullen said many of the cases they have traced involved situations where people attended events without a mask.

DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION

Elvira Wastewater Project Update: County Sanitarian Shane McClintock reported they have agreements ready for the residents to sign. McClintock said if a resident doesn't sign a cease and desist order can be signed and the system could be plugged which could cause damage to the home. McClintock believes the agreement is very friendly and doesn't expect anyone to opt out. Srp said after years of research on this project this agreement was easily the best solution for all involved. Wolf asked about a community meeting or what is the best way to share information to the residents about the agreements. Srp suggested that a mailer would address most of the questions. Determann thinks a WebEx meeting should be offered. A meeting will be scheduled for August 26.
