Life Connections Peer Recovery Center

The Peer Recovery Center is for those who are looking for a place to go for social activities, Groups, one on one conversations, and a place to be among others who are in Recovery with a Mental Health issue. This is a free place providing an atmosphere in which an individual's recovery is supported through the use of one-to-one peer support within the wellness center and eventually a Peer respite house.

Life Connections is a Peer Run Non-for Profit Organization, it has trained Peer Recovery Specialist in the past 3 years and now is opening the door for individuals seeking out a place to go were they are not judged by their diagnosis but welcomed through their experiences. The Center is just the beginning, we are working with the Mental Health Region, Trinity Hospital, and Genesis Hospital on the opening of Iowa's First Peer Run Respite House, so come join us in the devolvement of the Peer Movement and the opportunity to have a place to go when the hospital is not always the answer for everyone.
