**Clinton County, IA:** The Blue Ribbon Panel (BRP) of CCJCC convened on August 24th at the DeWitt Satellite Office. The group heard information about the Clinton County Jail, Sheriff's Office and 911 Communications Center. Sheriff Rick Lincoln, Jail Administrator Lt. Craig Eberhart and 911 Communications Director Eric Dau spoke. Jail Tour schedule was announced and distributed. **(\*Jail Tour schedule is listed below.)\***

The BRP discussed how the cities and county share joint operations with the County Jail and 911 Communications Center. One of the goals for the group is to study the possibility of implementing a Public Safety Authority (PSA).

County Attorney Mike Wolf answered PSA questions and Supervisor Dan Srp highlighted recent architectural drawings. CCJCC Coordinator M. Kuhl distributed project FAQs and spoke about the Programs and classroom space at the proposed replacement facility.
