Dear Chairman Staszewski,

The Clinton County Jail was inspected on March 13, 2013 by the Iowa Department of Corrections, as required by Iowa Code Section 356, to ensure compliance with Chapter 201-50 of the Iowa Administrative Code. The inspection included an examination of staff training records, required documentation, prisoner files, jail policy and procedures and a tour of the jail.

Clinton County Jail is an older facility that does not meet the current needs of the county, staff, or prisoners.

The jail is a well-managed and maintained facility. However, this is an older facility that will require continued maintenance.

Major improvements include the installation of a Kiosk machine and maintenance of the showers.

It is a pleasure to work with the professional staff of the Clinton County Jail.

Upon completion of the above corrective actions, the Clinton County Jail will be in compliance with Chapter 201-50 of the Iowa Administrative Code.

I wish to thank Lt. Craig Eberhart, Sgt Joe Steffen, Maintenance Personnel Cory Johnson, and the jail staff for their cooperation and assistance during the inspection.
