WHEREAS, the Clinton County Board of Supervisors has chosen to appoint a County Treasurer in accordance with Code of Iowa Sections 69.8 and 69.14A(2); and

WHEREAS, the Clinton County Board of Supervisors has caused a publication announcing its intent to appoint a County Treasurer and said public notice was published in the Clinton County official newspapers per Code of Iowa Sections 69.14A(2) and 331.305 ; now

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Board of Supervisors of Clinton County, Iowa, that _____, _____, Iowa, be appointed to and duly sworn in as the Clinton County Treasurer starting April 1, 2020, until after the canvass of votes for either a petitioned Special Election to fill the vacancy or when the seat appears on the November 3, 2020, General Election, to fill a vacancy.
