The Board of Supervisors of Clinton County, Iowa, met. Present were Supervisors Srp, Determann and Irwin. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

Coronavirus/COVID-19 update: County Community Health Manager Michelle Cullen reported the County has 66 additional cases. She said there was another death for a total of 22 in the County. There are currently 282 active cases in the County. She said only one nursing home is now in outbreak status and the Alverno will need to go 28 days without a case to drop the outbreak status. Cullen said positivity rate in the County is around 7% the last few days. She said new guidance has changed that if a positive person is wearing and mask and you are wearing a mask then that does not count as close contact and would not have to quarantine. However, if you live with someone diagnosed that is still a close contact. She said regionally there are eight in the hospital in the County. But across the region there has been a jump. She said they have been asked to start planning an immunization plan for the community.

DEPARTMENT HEADS, ELECTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES

County Auditor Eric Van Lancker reported in person absentee voting has started in the cafeteria of the Clinton County Administration Building.

County HR Director Dawn Aldridge said flu shots for employees have started. She said after that employee health screenings will begin and it appears there will be a very good turnout for that program. She said the three union contracts in the County will need to be recertified this year through an election. She is working on notifications for employees who belong to those unions.

EMA Director Chance Kness reported FEMA has awarded individual assistance to Clinton County for those that received damage during the derecho. He suggested that people applying should use the phone process to apply. He said folks should apply even if they have insurance. He said the current deadline is October 19. Kness said an extension has been applied for, but not yet determined. He said this is for people who were forced to leave their homes or their homes were damaged.

County Treasurer Dustin Johnson \$1.68 million is outstanding for the first half property payments of this fiscal year. He said there is a little more than \$600,000 from the last tax year currently uncollected. He said those will most likely be included in the next tax sale.

County Engineer Todd Kinney said Drainage District #22 project should be wrapping up soon. He's working on FEMA documents for damage from the derecho. He said the paving projects are also wrapping up soon.

DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION

County Recorder deputy replacement process: County Recorder Scott Judd reported he would like to restructure his office after a retirement in the spring of next year. He said his realignment would save approximately in \$16,000 when completely implemented. He said there would also be other savings when considering benefits. Judd said he will need a budget amendment of a little more than \$22,000 this fiscal year to bring someone in to train. Chairman Srp said the response to the plan is positive and they look forward to the resolutions to place it in action.

Elvira Wastewater Project Financing Options: County Sanitarian Shane McClintock reported they were able to get an estimate for individual homes. He believes those estimate could likely be reduced. He reviewed a packet of information that will be sent to the property owners. County Attorney Mike Wolf said this program will be done through special assessments to finance the project for the residents. Wolf said the fixed amount would be needed before the assessment can be assigned. McClintock said there are four easements that are needed before the bidding process can begin. He will send the packets to all the residents by certified letter.

County Administration Building Generator: Srp said the derecho highlighted some issues with the generator and what systems it should run. Srp said it was supposed to run heating/cooling, IT and basic operations. He said it was found out that was not the case when it was called to be placed into action. Srp said the County can apply for a FEMA grant to replace the generator. Supervisor Irwin said an electrician should look at the system and provide a suggestion on what happened. Irwin said someone dropped the ball. A test should have been conducted to determine what it is running. Irwin wants an electrician to look at the system. Van Lancker suggested an electrical engineer to review the current system and recommend potential fixes. Srp will work on an application for EMA funds to have an electrician review the system.
