**Clinton County Seeks Applicants for a
County Conservation Board Seat**

CLINTON – The Clinton County Board of Supervisors will again be appointing someone to a vacant seat on the Clinton County Conservation Board and is asking for those interested to submit their application.

The Board of Supervisor recently filled two seats, but another has recently become vacated. The appointment is for a term that ends November 1, 2021.

The Board of Supervisors expects to make the appointment during its Feb. 4, 2019, meeting. Applications are due by Jan. 31. The Board will also consider applications that were recently submitted.

Any Clinton County resident who is age 18 or older may apply by completing, signing and submitting the application form. The form should be submitted to: Board of Supervisors; PO Box 2957; Clinton, IA 52733-2957.
