**Clinton County Seeks Applicants for

CLINTON – The Clinton County Board of Supervisors will soon be appointing two people to the Clinton County Conservation Board and is asking for those interested to submit their application.

One appointment is for a full five-year term and another appointment is to fill a vacancy on the board with four years remaining on the term.
