COVID-19 vaccine supply in Clinton and Jackson County is VERY limited and the amount that comes into the community varies from week to week. Demand for the vaccine remains very high. Not all members of the Priority Group or a Tier will be able to receive a vaccine immediately. Please be patient.

Vaccine Clinics General Information:

How can I register for a COVID-19 vaccine?

- At this time, there is no pre-registration to receive a COVID-19 vaccine.
- Phase 1B, Individuals 65+ years of age and individuals in Tier 1 (Law enforcement, PK-12 school staff, childcare staff, firefighters, and child welfare social workers) will be started on February 1, 2021 depending on vaccine allocations.

When will clinics be available?

- Small clinics will begin the week of February 1st and will be for the following individuals:
 - Individuals 65 year of age and older (65+)
 - Phase 1B, Tier 1 priority groups: PK-12 staff, early childhood education, child care workers, and first responders (police, fire, DHS) **** We are working directly with their employers to get the Tier 1 priority groups scheduled for vaccinations.**

Where will clinics be held?

65 year and older will be local pharmacies, providers or public health. 65 years and older should look for information from their local pharmacy and/or provider.

Updates will be sent out weekly and continue to be sent out using social media, websites, and local newspaper.
