**PUBLIC NOTICE**  
**NOTICE OF PRIMARY ELECTION**

Notice is hereby given that an election, being the Primary Election, in the County of Clinton, State of Iowa, has been called and ordered to be held Tuesday, June 2, 2026.

Polls will be open from 7:00 a.m. until 8:00 p.m. of the same day.

Voters may vote absentee by mail. Absentee ballot request forms may be requested from the Clinton County Auditor's Office by calling 563-244-0568 or by visiting Elections.ClintonCounty-IA.gov. All absentee ballot request forms for a mailed ballot must be received in the Clinton County Auditor's Office before 5:00 p.m. on May 18. Requests received after that time will be rejected in accordance to state law.

Voters may vote absentee in-person at the Clinton County Auditor's Office, 1900 N 3<sup>rd</sup> St., Clinton, IA, during regular business hours through June 1. The Clinton County Auditor's Office will also be open for Primary Election business Saturday, May 30, from 7:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.

Pre-registered voters are required to provide an approved form of identification at the polling place before receiving and casting a regular ballot. Voters who are not pre-registered – such as voters registering to vote on Election Day – and voters changing precincts must also provide proof of residence. A voter who is unable to provide an approved form of identification (or prove residence if required) 1) may have the voter's identity/residence attested to by another registered voter in the precinct, 2) prove identity and residence using Election Day Registration documents, or 3) cast a provisional ballot and provide proof of identity/residence at the County Auditor's Office by June 8, 2026, at 12:00 p.m. (noon). Election Day Registrant attestors must provide an approved form of identification.
