

JANUARY 24, 2022

The Board of Supervisors of Clinton County, Iowa, met. Present were Supervisors Determann, Irwin and Srp. Minutes of the previous meeting were read and approved.

9:00 A.M. Review Correspondence and Claims Call to Order – Pledge of Allegiance

9:15 A.M. Formal Action & Motions Claims Approved Unanimously

Coronavirus/COVID-19 update: Clinton Community Health Manager Michele Cullen reported 392 new cases were reported in last seven days. She said that is little down from last week's new cases of 426. Cullen said there have been some reports that the omicron variant will peak as early as today but the state is reporting it should be next week. She said hospitalizations are staying steady in the region at 227, MercyOne is up a little to 13 and Genesis is at 49 and have been in that range for a while now. Cullen said the County vaccination rate is at 55.6%. She said the positivity rate has continued to stay high at 27%. She added that home kits are not reported so that number is likely higher. She said the virus is very prevalent in the community and urged the use of mitigation practices. Cullen said their Test Iowa kits are running anywhere from two to four days to receive the results. She said the federal government website is on their Facebook page where anyone can sign up and receive test kits at home.

RESOLUTION 2022-30

WHEREAS, Iowa Code section 459.304(3) sets out the procedure if a Board of Supervisors wishes to adopt a "construction evaluation resolution" relating to the construction of a confinement feeding operation structure; and

WHEREAS, only counties that have adopted a construction evaluation resolution can submit to the Department of Natural Resources (DNR) an adopted recommendation to approve or disapprove a construction permit application regarding a proposed confinement feeding operation structure; and

WHEREAS, only counties that have adopted a construction evaluation resolution and submitted an adopted recommendation may contest the DNR's decision regarding a specific application; and

WHEREAS, by adopting a construction evaluation resolution the Board of Supervisors agrees to evaluate every construction permit application for a proposed confinement feeding operation structure received by the Board of Supervisors between February 1, 2022 and January 31, 2023 and submit an adopted recommendation regarding that application to the DNR; and

WHEREAS, the Board of Supervisors must conduct an evaluation of every construction permit application using the master matrix created in Iowa Code section 459.305, but the board's recommendation to the DNR may be

based on the final score on the master matrix or may be based on reasons other than the final score on the master matrix;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Clinton County Board of Supervisors that the Board of Supervisors hereby adopts this construction evaluation resolution pursuant to Iowa Code section 459.304(3).

DEPARTMENT HEADS, ELECTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES

County Auditor Eric Van Lancker reminded the Board meets tomorrow and Friday for budget work sessions. Supervisor Srp said Bridgeview no longer must have a County Supervisor appointed to its board but would like to continue their participation.

County Treasurer Dustin Johnson reported contiguous county titling will be delayed for another two weeks as the State has not yet been able to complete the training for the new system.

County Facilities Director Corey Johnson reported he has two companies visiting to provide quotes on the kitchen hood at the jail and the fire panel at the Courthouse. He has scheduled a meeting with an engineering firm to start looking at the elevator in the Courthouse.

DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION

County Administration Building Leases: Van Lancker said the current building leases come due at the end of the fiscal year. He would like to start to process of renewing the leases. He asked the Board if any changes were needed to the leases. It was decided no changes were needed.

Proposed US 30 Economic Impact Study: Determann said a study is being proposed and would like Clinton County to participate financially. Determann said two or three counties on the west side of the state have committed to fund a portion of the \$97,000 study. He thought Carroll County had already committed \$5,000. He said industry will also be asked for support. Determann said it is a major issue and top priority for County growth. Irwin said it is a major highway that people use to travel to and from work. Srp said those who have had their section done should be reminded that Clinton County was supportive of their sections. Determann would like the County to contribute \$25,000 to the study. Srp said he would be comfortable with up to \$10,000. He would like to see what other entities are willing to put up. He said Linn, Tama and Benton should have funds in this as well because of the previous Clinton County support. Srp said he hates to say it, but the DOT is going to consider the numbers they want to consider. Determann said commissioners come and go. Srp said he is willing to come back and discuss more at a later time.

MOTION by Supervisor Srp to approve Clinton County to contribute \$10,000 to the economic impact study proposed to be completed by Schneider on behalf of the Highway 30 group.
