DEPARTMENT HEADS, ELECTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES

County Auditor Eric Van Lancker reported a working committee made up of the Iowa Department of Management, some County Auditors and some County Assessors met Friday to breakdown the new property tax legislation and is hoping their report will be available soon. Van Lancker reminded the Board that the cap of \$3.50 was set in the mid 80's.

Supervisor George attended the Expansion Huddle with the City of Clinton and learned the groundbreaking for Atlas Roofing is August 23. She said the County may be asked in the future to annex property to the City of Low Moor for some development. She said a steel manufacturing company has entered into a lease for the IPSCO building. She added that on June 21 at the Sawmill Museum there will be a presentation on the condition of the levy in Clinton in regard to the expansion of Riverview Drive. She said the Clinton County Solid Waste Agency meeting reported there is seepage from a closed cell that needs to be addressed immediately. She said the agency also reviewed their employee policy including wage increases that were as high as 16%.

County Treasurer Dustin Johnson said used car registrations will be done electronically and should cut down in processing time.

County Sheriff Bill Greenwalt said they were just made aware of a change in the Seventh Judicial District Chief Judge as of July 7. The new Chief Judge will be Judge Henry Lathem. Current Chief Judge Marlita Greve is retiring July 7.

County EMA Director Chance Kness said they are working on flood damage assessments this week. He said Clinton and Camanche will be returning state-sponsored flood resources during the next two weeks.

DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION

Solar Project Application Update: Chairman Irwin said there have been a few conversations about this topic in the public about a moratorium on the project or future projects. Irwin said he had also heard current folks with leases have yet to receive anything from the solar company. Irwin said that is between them and the solar company. County Attorney Mike Wolf said there is not a justifiable reason for the moratorium at this point. He said one would be good at some point to add new rules in the County ordinances. Wolf added the current application is agreeable to the proposed new rules. Wolf added this is an expansion of the current project. Planning and Zoning Director Thomas Barnes added the current request is just for a rezoning. Barnes said public notices went out last week for the May 25 Planning and Zoning Commission meeting. Bright Future Iowa representative Mike Carberry said he was pleased how thoughtful the conversation has been and the changes the Supervisors are making from what they learned during the last year. He added if a moratorium is needed that it should have an end date that will allow the ordinance updates to be done.
