Jeff Baker, a Clinton resident, questioned whether the state requirement is to live within the county and whether the county can make it less restrictive.

Chief Deputy Steave Diesch: A deputy was hired who lives in Fulton. For him to work, a change to the ordinance is needed to allow him to live there. He's already been through the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy, but because he is residing in Illinois, the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy requires that we change our ordinance. There is a probationary period of 9 months. At some point after that probationary period, relocation is expected.

Motion was made by Supervisor Srp to adjourn the Public Hearing.

ORDINANCE 2025- 05

AN ORDINANCE AMENDING THE CLINTON COUNTY CODE OF ORDINANCES BY THE ADDITION OF CHAPTER 7 SHERIFF’S DEPUTIES- RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT

Be It Ordained by the Board of Supervisors of Clinton County, Iowa:

SECTION 1. Chapter 7 of the Clinton County Code of Ordinances is the addition of a new Chapter, as follows:

- 1-7-1 PURPOSE: The purpose of this ordinance is to eliminate the state residency requirement for Clinton County Sheriff’s Deputies as required by the Iowa Law Enforcement Academy, Iowa Administrative Code 501-2.1 (1).
- 1-7-2 RESIDENCY REQUIREMENT ELIMINATED. As of the effective date of this ordinance, Clinton County Sheriff’s Deputies will no longer be required to be residents of the State of Iowa.
- 1-7-3 TIME AND DISTANCE REQUIREMENTS. The Sheriff’s Office shall assess the needs and demands of their office and shall establish a time and distance policy for the Deputies.

SECTION 2. Severability clause. If any section, provision or part of this ordinance shall be adjudged invalid or unconstitutional, such adjudication shall not affect the validity of the ordinance as a whole or any section, provision or part thereof not adjudged invalid or unconstitutional.

SECTION 3. When effective. This Ordinance shall be in full force and effect September 15, 2025 and upon posting as required by Iowa law.
