WHEREAS, the Clinton County Attorney has approved the externship field placement of the University of Iowa College of Law student T. # DEPARTMENT HEADS, ELECTED OFFICIALS AND EMPLOYEES

Supervisors shared the meetings they will each be attending this week.

Auditor: Provided no further updates, but wished everyone happy holidays and cautioned about current road conditions due to weather.

Treasurer: Announced hardware received for the MVD 360 update, to be rolled out second week of January, aiming to improve workflow.

The purchase would be made by the county and reimbursed by the Conservation Foundation through donor funds, not taxpayer funds.

First Reading Recap: The first reading occurred on November 24th, 2025, at Goose Lake High School, focusing on public input and discussion Proof of publication for today's meeting was confirmed.

Presentations from NextEra Energy Resources (Clinton County Wind): Kimberly Dickey & Dr. Julie Garvin: Presented on behalf of NextEra Energy Resources, highlighting their experience as the largest energy infrastructure developer in North America, with 30 years of project execution in Iowa since 1999 and to provide technical clarity on the proposed ordinance,

Public Presentation from Don Quixote Society: Gwen Rickertsen Clinton County is a poor location for wind energy projects due to high population density, karst topography, and its location within a major migratory bird corridor (Mississippi River/Driftless Area).
