DISCUSSION WITH POSSIBLE ACTION

Clinton County Opioid Fund Application: Formalize how organizations request opioid settlement funds

MOTION made by Supervisor George to approve the use of the opioid application as presented to the Board of Supervisors.

Approve Waiver or Reduction Of Fees Associated with the *Observer's* March 26, 2026, Open Records Request: The Board considered a request to waive or reduce fees associated with a Freedom of Information Act (FOIA) request submitted on March 26, 2026. It was reported that fulfillment of the request required approximately eight to ten hours of County Attorney time, in addition to review by outside legal counsel due to the sensitive nature of the records and the need to ensure compliance with applicable law. The total cost incurred for outside legal services was approximately \$632, of which a fee of \$150 was proposed to be assessed to the requesting party, representing a portion of the total expense. A discussion was held regarding the appropriateness of the proposed fee.

Budgetary funding of FOIA response expenses: A budget line will be created for costs associated with formal FOIA requests.

Possible Review and Amendment of the Clinton County Data Center Ordinance 4.2.21: Members of the Board emphasized that the intent of the ordinance was not to prohibit development, but rather to ensure the County retains the ability to review proposals and engage with developers to pursue projects that provide long-term economic value. Concerns were raised that the current ordinance language may be perceived as overly restrictive and could discourage potential investment.

The Board further discussed the importance of economic development in supporting the County's financial sustainability, including the need to diversify and expand the tax base to offset rising service and infrastructure costs.

Public comment was received from Andy Sokolovich of Grow Clinton regarding the potential benefits and impacts of data center development. His Comments included support for considering such development as an opportunity to increase the County's tax base and promote long-term economic growth.

Additional remarks addressed infrastructure and utility capacity, noting that utility providers have indicated the ability to support such developments and that associated infrastructure costs would be borne by developers rather than existing residential users.

Concerns were also discussed regarding environmental impacts and regulatory oversight. It was noted that data centers are subject to state and utility regulations similar to those for other industrial developments and do not produce certain emissions commonly associated with traditional manufacturing.

Further comment questioned whether data centers are being uniquely scrutinized compared to other types of industrial development, suggesting that similar standards may not be consistently applied across industries.
