FY 2027 Budget Discussion

Discussion on potential impacts of pending Iowa legislation that could limit county general fund reserve balances to 35 percent beginning in Fiscal Year 2028. Discussion focused on the County's current reserve levels, possible financial and levy implications, and whether any immediate amendments to the recently adopted Fiscal Year 2027 budget were necessary. Following review by the Treasurer and Budget Director, the Board determined that recent revisions to the proposed legislation reduced the immediate urgency for action, and no changes were made to the FY2027 budget. The Supervisors emphasized the importance of maintaining ongoing budget and capital planning discussions while balancing tax relief, fiscal responsibility, and future county needs.

The Board of Supervisors adjourned to meet on Monday, May 4, 2026, at 9:00 a.m.
